Executive Summary

The Alumni Survey is a tool used to check-in on graduates approximately one year after graduation to determine the positive placement rate and "success" of these graduates by program. This survey also provides an opportunity to update contact information and helps maintain the lines of communication between Oklahoma State University Institute of Technology (OSUIT) and those who can support the institution in a number of ways. This 2021 alumni cohort consists of students who graduated during the 2019-2020 academic year (summer 2019 through spring 2020) resulting in a range of respondents who were anywhere from eight to 16 months post-graduation. The OSUIT Office of Institutional Research administered the Alumni Survey entirely online.

Of the 670 alumni who graduated during the 2019-2020 academic year, 629 had viable email addresses and were invited to participate in this survey; 54 responded to the survey for a response rate of 8.6 percent, up from 6.5 percent the previous year. Note that the number of participants affects the statistical power of the results; low numbers of participants result in less confidence that the reported outcomes generalize to the population as a whole. Thus, the results from the current administration of the Alumni Survey may exaggerate, unpredictably, the views of the alumni cohort in the present sample. Please use caution when interpreting the results contained within this report.

Less than half (25, 46.3%) of respondents were female, 29 (53.7%) were male, and 77.8 percent of alumni reported in-state addresses. The largest number of respondents graduated from the School of Arts, Sciences & Health (20, 37.0%) followed by the School of Engineering & Construction Technologies (17, 31.5%) and the School of Creative & Information Technologies (15, 27.8%). Overall positive placement of 81.5 percent included 39 (72.2%) respondents who reported employment in-field; five (9.3%) were employed in a field not related to their degree. Five (9.3%) alumni reported continuing their education, and three (5.6%) alumni reported seeking employment.

Among the 44 alumni reporting employment, 37 (81.5%) reported full-time employment. None of the respondents reported military service as employment. Thirty (55.6%) employed alumni reported having a job lined up before graduating; cumulatively, 39 (72.2%) reported gaining employment within 6 months of graduation (3, 5.6% took over six months to find employment). Of the 43 respondents reporting salary data, 18 (33.3%) reported earnings in excess of \$60,000 per year. Alumni reported salary data with a median pay range of \$55,000-\$59,999.

Previous alumni survey rating scales included a neutral category in a five-point Likert-type format; this year, the scales were adjusted to a forced-choice four-point format by removing the neutral category. Alumni expressed the highest levels of satisfaction (either 3= Satisfied or 4= Very Satisfied) in the following areas:

- Instructors' knowledge of subject area (90.7%)
- Instructors' willingness to help me meet educational goals (88.9%)
- Instructors' willingness to help me meet career goals (87.0%)
- Analytical skills (85.2%)
- Problem-solving skills (85.2%)

Alumni expressed lowest satisfaction (same scale as above; either 3= Satisfied or 4= Very Satisfied) in the following areas:

- Student club/organization associated with my program (66.7%)
- Opportunities for off-campus practical experience in my chosen career field (72.2%)
- Quality of on-campus applied learning & practical experiences (72.2%)
- Availability of technology similar to what is used in the field (74.1%)
- Leadership skills (74.1%, up from 60.5% last year; this represents largest *increase* in work-related skills satisfaction for 2021)

Alumni reported highest levels of agreement (either 3=Agree or 4=Strongly Agree) regarding the following statements:

- OSUIT helped me achieve my educational goals (85.2%)
- Overall, I am satisfied with my education from OSUIT (79.6%)
- I would choose to attend OSUIT again (79.6%)
- OSUIT provided opportunities for relevant field experience in my career field (79.6%)

Alumni reported lowest levels of agreement (either 3=Agree or 4=Strongly Agree) regarding the statement "OSUIT helped me develop contacts with industry professionals" (68.5%).

Five-Year Comparison


The results for 2021 show increased satisfaction for most items in the area of Work-related Skills with substantial increases in satisfaction with the development of *communication, leadership,* and *problem-solving* skills. Alumni also reported generally higher satisfaction with their educational experiences at OSUIT and particularly for *instructors' knowledge of their subject areas* and *willingness to help students meet their educational goals*. Alumni were also generally satisfied with experiences that led to the attainment of educational goals in preparation for employment; however, alumni were less satisfied with OSUIT in terms of gaining *the proper skills needed for my chosen career*. The survey ended with three summary items that provide an overall picture of alumni attitudes toward OSUIT; on these, alumni appeared more reserved about *recommending OSUIT to family and friends* and less *satisfied with my education from OSUIT* compared to results from the previous year.

Following is a five-year summary of the rates of positive responses (ratings of 3 or 4—satisfied/very satisfied or agree/strongly agree-- on a four-point scale) for each scale and scale item on the alumni survey. Note: When interpreting these results, remember that some areas of focus are less important or may not apply to alumni from non-technical programs or without internship experiences. In such cases, these may result in fewer responses or lower percentages of positive scores (ex., off-campus field experience or taking direction from a supervisor), particularly if the alumni continued their education and had not yet entered the workforce. Also, changes this year in the response scales from five-point to four-point, with the removal of the "neutral" response, result in a forced-choice to clarify the direction of responses.




