PLA = Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) available. The amount of prior learning credit awarded toward the AAS in Applied Technology will vary by individual and based upon presentation and institutional review of a student portfolio of approved licenses, certifications, and other industry-recognized credentials. Student may earn a maximum of 75% of degree requirements (45 credit hours) through a combination of PLA and transfer credit.
