You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid administrator at your school. Your school may ask for additional information. If you have verification questions, contact your financial aid administrator as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

Verification of 2021 Income Information for Individuals with Unusual Circumstances

Individuals Granted a Filing Extension by the IRS

If an individual is required to file a 2021 IRS income tax return and has been granted a filing extension by the IRS, provide the following documents:

- A copy of IRS Form 4868, "Application for Automatic Extension of Time to File U.S. Individual Income Tax Return," that was filed with the IRS for tax year 2021.
- A copy of the IRS's approval of an extension beyond the automatic six-month extension if the individual requested an
 additional extension of the filing time for tax year 2021; and
- A copy of IRS Form W-2 for each source of employment income received for tax year 2021 and, if self-employed, a signed statement certifying the amount of the individual's Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) and the U.S. income tax paid for tax year 2021.

Individuals Who Filed an Amended IRS Income Tax Return

If an individual filed an amended IRS income tax return for tax year 2021, provide both of the following:

- A 2021 IRS Tax Return Transcript; or
- Signed copy of the 2021 IRS Federal Tax Return including IRS Schedules 1, 2, and 3 sent to the IRS, OR complete the IRS Data Retrieval Tool
- A **signed copy** of the 2021 IRS Form 1040X, "Amended U.S. Individual Income Tax Return," that was filed with the IRS.

Individuals Who Were Victims of IRS Identity Theft

• A victim of IRS identity theft who is not able to obtain a 2021 IRS Tax Return Transcript or use the IRS DRT must contact the IRS at 1-800-908-4490. Upon authentication of the tax filer's identity, the IRS will provide, by U.S. Postal Service, a printout of the tax filer's 2021 IRS income tax return information.

Individuals Who Filed Non-IRS Income Tax Returns

- An individual filed or will file a 2021 income tax return with Puerto Rico, another U.S. territory (e.g., Guam, American Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Northern Marianas Islands), or with a foreign country, must provide a signed copy of that 2021 income tax return(s).
- Convert amounts earned to U.S. currency, providing the equivalent to each parent's income from work, Adjusted Gross Income, Income Taxes Paid.

Each person signing this worksheet certifies that all reported information is complete and correct. The student must sign, spouse signature is optional. Warning: If you purposely give false or misleading information on this worksheet, you may be fined, sentenced to jail, or both.
