Scholarship Requirements:

Kirschner Endowment - Orphan 21 or Under

An orphan is defined as a student who, before the age of 18, has lost both natural parents due to death or one parent due to death with the other parent being classified as widowed or single. FAFSA not required

Kirschner for Students with Disabilities

This scholarship is designed for students with a disability as identified by Disability Determination Services through the Social Security Administration. FAFSA not required
